- 4. What does Beck see as the future of the city? What does he want to see happen?
- 5. How do you understand Beck's motivations for writing this piece? To answer this, google Beck to learn a bit about him. (He's also discussed briefly in the second article.)
- 6. Over the history of Wisconsin beginning when English speakers started coming, are there other 'ordeals of immigration' that you can name? How do they compare to this situation? How have they played out historically?
